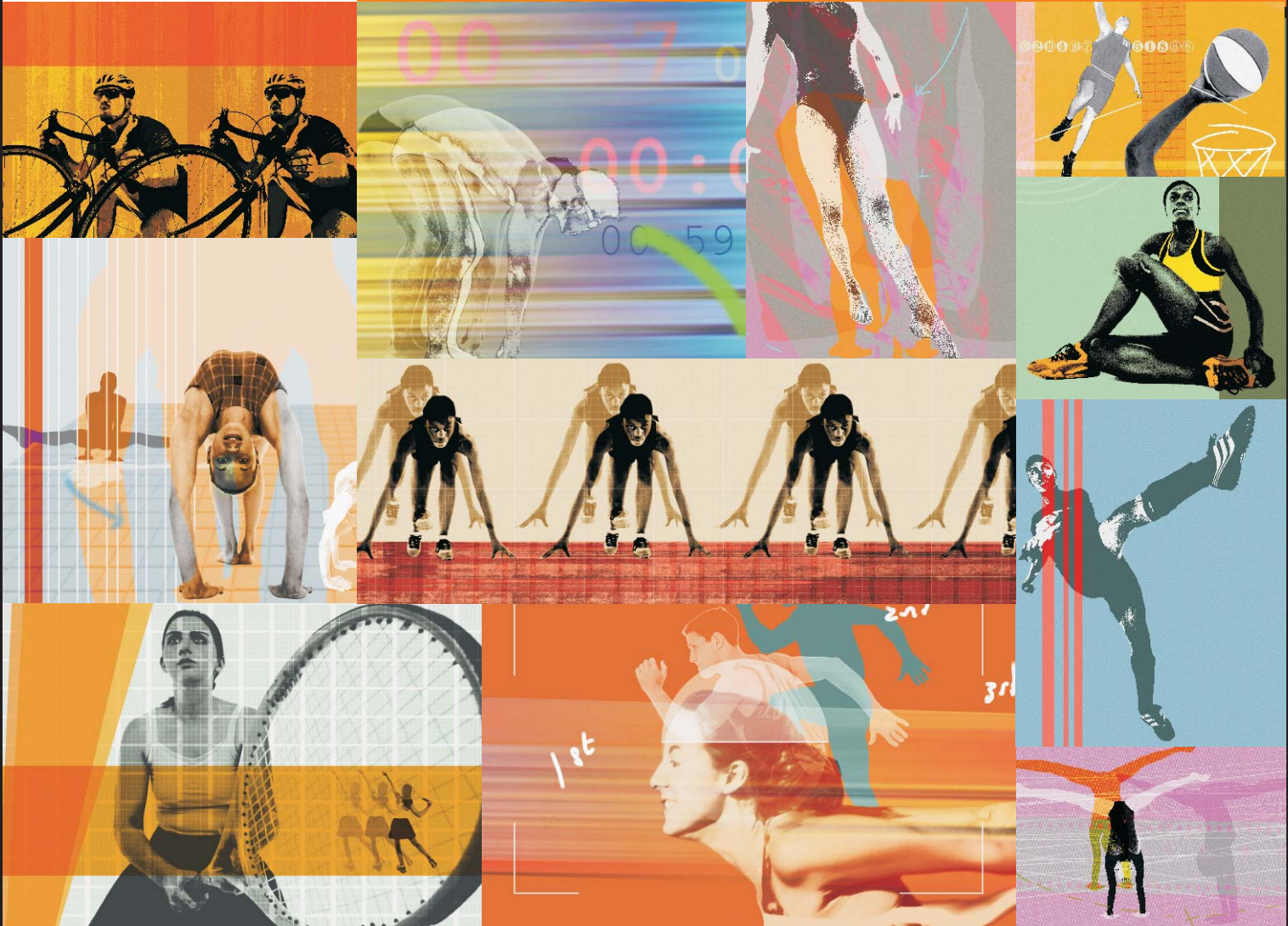

Sport Reading Futures Programme

The Sport Reading Futures programme is a scheme by Reading Sports Aid Fund in partnership with Reading Sport Leisure, Greenwich Leisure, AcademySport, Prudential Rivers Ibis Club and Reading Borough Council.

What the Scheme provides...

The scheme provides sports people at a National Level, with free access to training facilities within participating leisure facilities in Reading. These sites are Rivermead Leisure Complex, Meadway Sports Centre, Palmer Park Sports Stadium, Arthur Hill Pool & Fitness Studio, Central Swimming Pool, AcademySport and Ibis Rivers Club.

Eligibility for the Scheme...

The Scheme aims to help and support national sports people of all ages. To be eligible for the scheme you must meet the following criteria:



- A current national sports person from any Sport England recognised sport, at any age group. National is deemed as either a member of a National team/squad, or ranked in the top ten overall in the Country of an individual sport or discipline.
- A resident of Reading Borough for the majority of the year or a member of a Reading-based sports club or attending a Reading school.
- Supporting evidence from the governing body will be required upon application e.g. letter from your NGB inviting you to a National/International competition, results, or ranking verification.

How the Scheme works...

Members of the Sport Reading Futures Scheme are entitled to use any of the eight leisure centres participating in Reading (as detailed above) free of charge. Members will be issued with an identity card and will be required to show their card each time they visit a centre to gain free access.

What Reading Sports Aid Fund expect in return from their members...

In return for the benefits offered, Reading Sports Aid Fund and the participating leisure facilities request members' assistance in promoting activities and events whenever possible (minimum of one event per year).

Reading Sports Aid are keen to monitor how the Scheme benefits its members, how often facilities and services are used, as well as news of its members' recent competitions, results, national representation and ranking. Each member is required to inform Reading Sports Aid of his or her progress and successes throughout the year and usage levels of facilities.

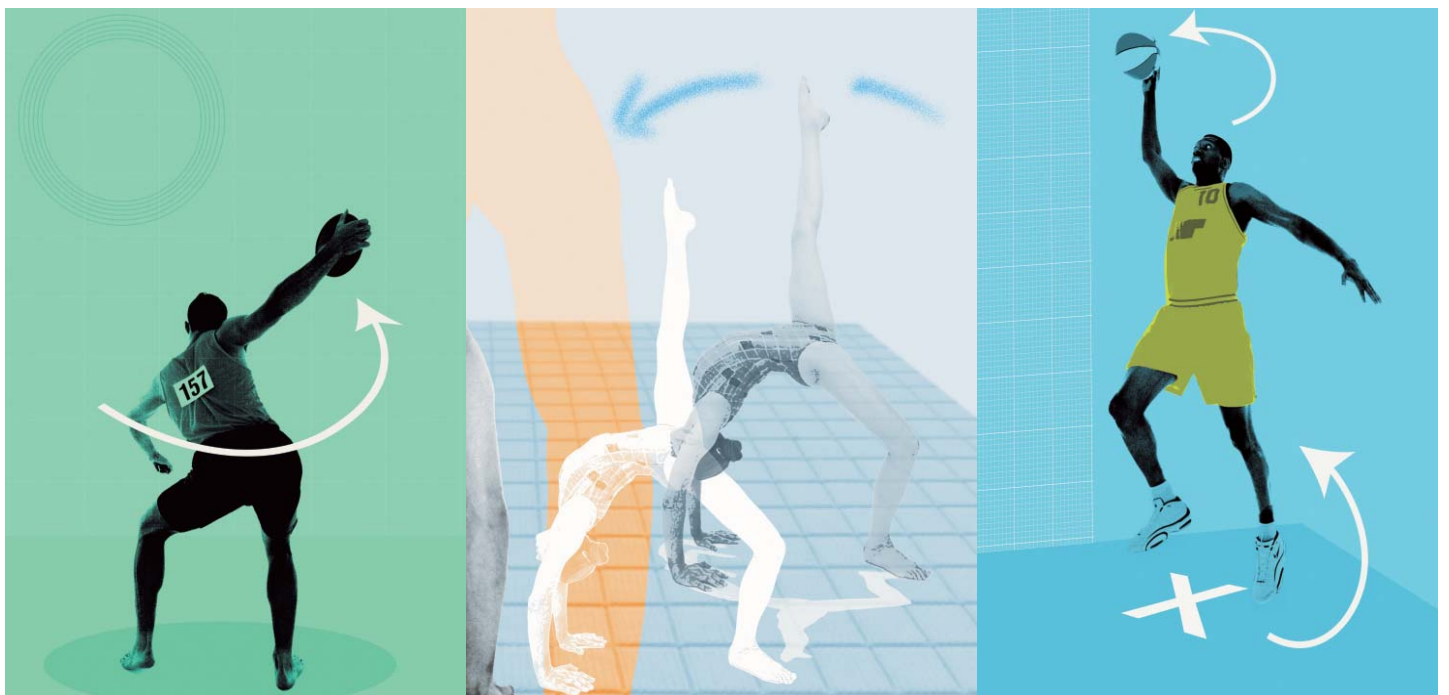
