Summary

Following a review of the responses received in relation to the statutory consultation for the East Reading area Resident Permit Parking scheme, Officers propose a revision to the recommended actions of the abovementioned report. This revision has been considered necessary due to the volume and content of objections to specific items within the proposed Traffic Regulation Order.

The recommended amendments are typed in *italic* text as follows:

2. RECOMMENDED ACTION

2.1 That the Sub-Committee notes the report.

Part a:

2.2 That the objections and other comments in Appendix 1a, 2a-c and 3a are considered and the Sub-Committee agrees to either implement, amend or reject the proposals.

2.3 *Officers recommend that the marked bay restriction (shared-use) on Whiteknights Road (TRO 1) is removed from the resultant Traffic Regulation Order. It is recommended that Officers conduct a statutory consultation for the proposed implementation of double-yellow-lines in place of this proposed bay. Recommendations 2.8 - 2.12 will, therefore, additionally apply to this proposed statutory consultation.*

2.4 *Officers recommend that the proposed restrictions for Wokingham Road (TRO 1) be removed from the resultant Traffic Regulation Order and that revised proposals are recommended*

for statutory consultation at a future meeting of the Sub-Committee.

- 2.5 Should a decision be made to implement the proposals, that the Head of Legal and Democratic Services be authorised to seal the resultant Traffic Regulation Orders, and no public inquiry be held into the proposals.
- 2.6 That, should funding permit, Officers develop the proposals for implementation.
- 2.7 That respondents to the statutory consultation be informed of the decision of the Sub-Committee accordingly

Part b:

- 2.8 That the Head of Legal and Democratic Services be authorised to carry out the statutory consultation and advertise the proposals in Appendix 4, in accordance with the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996.
- 2.9 That subject to no objections being received, the Head of Legal and Democratic Services be authorised to make the Traffic Regulation Order.
- 2.10 That any objections received during the statutory consultation be reported to a future meeting of the Sub-Committee.
- 2.11 That the Head of Transportation and Streetcare, in consultation with the appropriate Lead Councillor be authorised to make minor changes to the proposals.
- 2.12 That no public enquiry be held into the proposals.
